- Recognising decisions and actions should provide for broad community involvement on issues which affect them
- Incorporating sustainability performance alongside other key performance indicators of AP business.
- Ensuring sustainability is reflected in AP's management system and reporting documents.
- Providing training and support for staff to adopt sustainability principles and practices to achieve sustainable behaviour change in the workplace.
